

Awards & Prizes

Be recognized for your extraordinary achievement!!

Individual fundraising awards – Incentives are available for \$250 up to \$10,000 raised. There are separate fliers for this. Incentives will be distributed as certificates. Certificates will direct walkers to a website where they log in, put in the certificate number and pick a prize which will be shipped directly to them. Winners can choose from any prize at their level and any level below. Only funds from donations/team money or track sign money will count. (Luminaria, corporate sponsor & registration money will not be included). Team captains must turn in a list of eligible team members by deadline. (Forms will be provided) Only monies collected by the end of the event will be included. Team captains will need to distribute certificates to their eligible team members. Certificates will have an expiration date and must be redeemed before they expire.



Team Fundraising Awards...the Fundraising Club... Earn a sign for your campsite. Only monies from your team's fundraising efforts will be included. Money from luminaries, registration, and corporate sponsorships will not be included. Signs will be awarded to teams for their present fundraising level at the event. Then, throughout the event (specific times will be provided prior to the event), signs will be changed as your team total achieves a new level. Here are the levels:

Celebrate Club - \$1,000	Platinum Club - \$15,000 - \$24,999
Bronze Club - \$2500 - \$4999	Purple Club - \$25,000+
Silver Club - \$5,000 - \$9,999	
Gold Club - \$10,000 - \$14,999	



Total Funds per capita – Total monies raised by your team divided by number of people on the team. 10 youth team awards and 10 adult team awards will be given. Framed certificates will be awarded to the winners.

Total over all funds raised – All monies collected for your team will count in this award. 10 youth teams and 10 adult teams will be honored with framed certificates.

Campsite Decoration Award – First and Second place will be handed out. We will use a traveling sign that is of the same style as the track signs and will be moved to the new winner every year.

Best Money & Record manager – Awarded by the registration committee to the team captain who keeps the best records, always comes prepared with money counted, forms prepared, envelopes filled out, no coin and accurate count.

Most Creative Team token – Awarded to team that gets the most votes for their token. Teams must provide a coffee can or box for people to submit votes in order to participate in the award.

Most Luminarias sold by bank night – Get your team to turn in their forms early. Make sure that your team's name is on your forms. 3 Pizzas and some soda will be provided at the event as the prize.

Spirit recognition/Golden Pillowcase Award – Determined by participation in cancer control messaging and other activities, costumes, willingness to help out when asked, taking on an event project i.e. recycling, trash, etc. – Basically displaying a total Relay Spirit and American Cancer Society spirit. Verbal nomination to Jessie, Chris, Shannon or a section leader. They will pick from the nominations. Anyone can submit a nomination. Use this to share stories and spread the warmth of Relay.

Team Meeting Award – At each meeting you attend, you will put your name into a drawing bucket. You must stay for the meeting to be eligible. Door prizes will be awarded at every meeting and one big one at wrap up. This year's big gift is a Relay Wallet and a Wireless Mouse with a Flash Drive. There could be one other surprise gift. You must be present to win. Don't miss out on the quizzes and game prizes at every meeting as well. Read your team captain's handbook for the answers.

Team Parade Award – Team parade will happen as part of closing ceremonies. Awards will be presented to team with most people in the parade and team with most creative costumes/banners/team spirit.

Online Fundraising – 3 awards will be handed out – one for the person who sends the most emails, one for the individual who raises the most money online through the sending of online emails, one for the team that raises the most money through sending online emails.
