

## **Wrist Band Guidelines**

All wrist bands will be distributed at the “Youth Table” on the day of the event. Wristbands need to be picked up immediately when your team arrives at the Youth team information booth. Wristbands are to be distributed immediately upon receipt and worn for the whole of the event. You will be provided different colored wrist bands for overnight youth. These should be worn all day as well. This will help us distinguish who is just there for the day with a team and who is spending the night.

Each team is to submit the Emergency Contact Form (by the deadline) which is located in the disc included in the Relay for Life Team Captain Packet. This form indicates how many youth (defined as anyone under the age of 21) are involved with the team and it also notifies committee members as to who is camping overnight.

We are asking each team captain to write their team name on the overnight wrist bands before distributing them to their team members for identification during the overnight hours. Students should be wearing wristbands at all times during Relay – day and night.

Vouchers will be given to anyone handing in a donation envelope at the event indicating that they are eligible for a wrist band. These vouchers should then be given to the team chaperone or team captain who will collect all vouchers and bring them to the Youth Table to secure bracelets. These team members will need to be added to the emergency contact list if they are not already there. Please be sure to have contact information available for them. No contact information – no wristband.

Once vouchers are turned in only the team captain or the team chaperone can receive the wrist bands for distribution.

All youth must wear these wrist bands while in attendance at the Relay for Life.
